

Board Policy

Crisis Management

When a crisis arises, immediate, effective and responsible management and communication can resolve the crisis and maintain the organization's integrity and credibility. Therefore, Eastern Suffolk BOCES shall develop and maintain a unified position by:

1. preparing, maintaining, and distributing an Emergency Handbook and
2. identifying a media liaison who will be briefed on all details. The spokesperson shall be the Chief Operating Officer or designee. Only the designated spokesperson(s) shall speak to, and maintain a timely flow of information to, the media.

The administration shall be responsible for informing employees of the procedures in the handbook.
