

Board Policy

Use of Behavior Intervention Rooms

The use by Eastern Suffolk BOCES of a Behavior Intervention Room (BIR) shall be governed by the policies, rules, and standards pursuant to 8 New York Code of Rules and Regulations (NYCRR) Section 200.22(c) of the Commissioner's Regulations and 8 NYCRR 19.5 of the Rules of the Board of Regents. A timeout room (referred to herein as a "BIR") is a room and area for a student to safely deescalate, regain control, and prepare to meet expectations- to return to his/her educational program. The BIR shall only be used in conjunction with a behavioral intervention plan developed for the Student and/or Board Policy 6211.
