Statewide Uniform Violent Incident Reporting System

In compliance with the Uniform Violent Incident Reporting System, Eastern Suffolk BOCES will record each violent or disruptive incident that occurs on ESBOCES property or at an ESBOCES function. On or before September 30 of each year (commencing 2002), ESBOCES will submit an annual report of violent or disruptive incidents to the Commissioner in the manner prescribed.

ESBOCES will establish local procedures for the reporting of violent or disruptive incidents by each building and/or program under its jurisdiction. Copies of such incident reports will be retained for the time prescribed by the Commissioner in the applicable records retention schedule. These reports will be available for inspection by the New York State Education Department upon request.

All personally identifiable information included in a violent or disruptive incident report will be confidential and will not be disclosed to any person for any purpose other than that specified in §2802 of the NYS Education Law, except as otherwise authorized by law.

Beginning with the 2002-03 school year, ESBOCES will include a summary of the ESBOCES annual violent or disruptive incident report in its ESBOCES Report Card in the format prescribed by the Commissioner of Education.
